Infinity Power Cord

Crystal Cable launched the Infinity power cord in 2024 to mark the company's 20th anniversary – it took seven years to develop and features 18 conductors (nine for positive and nine for negative), made of monocrystalline silver and a silver/gold alloy.

Originally sold in strictly limited numbers, it became clear that the power cord was so good and so popular that Infinity couldn't just remain in the systems of a select handful of listeners. Even at its substantial cost, due in part to its extended construction time, Infinity has proved a hit.

Reviewing it, we said it was expensive but, "in the context of a high-end system, it brings impressive rewards. In the ultra-high end systems it is designed for, it is the icing on a very rewarding acoustic cake."

Monet Interconnect Cables



The Monet is part of the company's Art Series and uses the brand's tenth generation Infinite Crystal (iCS) pure silver conductors. The thinnest cables in the series, they nevertheless embody the full power of Crystal Cable's reputation for innovation and engineering. In particular, the conductors are designed to be completely smooth, and free from microfissures on their surface.

With a luxurious look and feel, the cable's architecture accommodates the widest range of audio equipment, although, it's unlikely that anyone will use it with entry-level gear.

We said: "While not everyone has a sufficiently girthy bank balance or a system of the gravitas expected by Crystal's Monet, those fortunate enough to have both are in for a treat."

Edwin Rynveld was already well-known in the audio world for his high-performance Siltech cables. Crystal was founded on a similarly clear philosophy: to transmit music with absolute purity while blending cutting-edge engineering with sleek, minimalist design.

Building on Rynveld's background in metallurgy and electronics, Crystal Cable aimed to challenge traditional cable concepts through advanced materials and precise manufacturing.

At the core of Crystal Cable's technology is the use of ultra-pure, monocrystal silver and gold-silver alloy conductors.
